EAGLE ISLAND CAMP, XAXABA ISLAND

Eagle Island Camp at Xaxaba is one of the Delta's most pristine natural locations, a region of myriad waterways, palm-treed islands and vast flood plains.

Activities

During the months of April through October the camp offers a choice of game viewing by mokoro (traditional dugout canoe), motorized boats and sundowner barges to the surrounding lagoons. When water levels are low (December through March), morning, afternoon and evening game drives are offered in open 4x4 vehicles. Guided safari walks are offered all year around on the surrounding islands. An inclusive helicopter game-viewing flight of 45 minutes is offered to all guests as part of their safari program.

The Team

Eagle Island is managed by an experienced management couple who are supported by an assistant manager, an environmentalist, four qualified guides, helicopter pilot and an operations team.

Accommodation and Amenities

* 11 En-suite luxury tents with thatched roofs set on raised wooden decks overlooking the Xaxaba Lagoon. Each tent is equipped with individual gas geysers; "his & hers" vanity unit; a shaving mirror; hair dryer; fully stocked mini bar; a private viewing deck with hammock and easy chairs; electric overhead fan and lighting; electric heaters and air-conditioning; 110v/220v plugs and adaptors for electric razors, digital cameras and laptop computers are available for the tents.

Each tent is also equipped with an internal telephone to reception and to other tents, an electronic in-room safe, and is equipped with a 24 hour electricity supply for your comfort and safety.

The Suite

The Suite has all the amenities of our standard tents with the addition of: a private heated plunge pool, outside bathroom with bath tub, large deck area for private dining and your own personal guide for private game viewing excursions.

Lodge Facilities

* Separate under-cover dining and lounge areas with views over the surrounding floodplains* Fireplace and lounge area * The Fish Eagle Bar for game viewing and private dinners * Private library with internet facilities and satellite TV * Large heated swimming pool * Off site cocktail and dinner venue

Meals and Refreshments included in your stay

Early morning tea/coffee delivered to rooms at wake up, a light breakfast prior to the morning game drive/boat activity, and during the morning game drive, tea, coffee and biscuits. On returning to the camp a full buffet brunch is offered followed by time to rest and relax. A light tea will precede the afternoon game drive/boat activity during which wine, beer, soft drinks & snacks will be served at sundown. The table d'hote dinner is served in the main dining area with a wine presentation.

Access to Eagle Island

By scheduled air from Johannesburg via Maun or Livingstone, Zambia where you will continue via scheduled shared charter aircraft. Note: all shared charter flights to the camps are via single engine Cessna aircraft. Twin-engine and private charter aircraft are available on request.

Luggage Restrictions

Unless travelling by road or by special prior arrangement, luggage is restricted to 20 kg or 44 pounds in soft sided bags (due to the limited hold capacity of the shared charter flights). Extra luggage can be stored free of charge at our offices in Maun, Cape Town or Johannesburg by prior arrangement. Alternatively, excess luggage can also be flown to a camp or other destination by prior arrangement..

A Stay at Eagle Island Camp

Is fully inclusive of all scheduled game activities, a daily laundry service, all meals, all house wines and spirits, soft drinks, beers and bottled water (but excluding imported champagne and cigars) national park fees, emergency evacuation insurance and Botswana VAT.
