KHWAI RIVER LODGE, MOREMI WILDLIFE RESERVE

Nestled on the edge of a leadwood and fig tree forest, overlooking the vast Khwai River floodplains and beyond into the Moremi Wildlife Reserve,

Activities

Activities at the camp include morning and afternoon game drives in open 4X4 vehicles, after-dark spotlight game drives and guided safari walks along the Khwai River. Cultural visits to the local Khwai village can also be arranged as can full day excursions to the Okavango Delta

The Team

Khwai is managed by an experienced management couple who are supported by an assistant manager, an environmentalist, five qualified guides, an executive chef, beauty therapist and an operations team.

Accommodation and Amenities

* 14 En-suite luxury tents with thatched roofs set on raised wooden decks overlooking the Khwai floodplain. Each tent is equipped with individual gas geysers; "his & hers" vanity unit; a shaving mirror; hair dryer; fully stocked mini bar; a private viewing deck with hammock and easy chairs; electric overhead fan and lighting; electric heaters and air-conditioning; 110v/220v plugs and adaptors for electric razors, digital cameras and laptop computers are available for the tents. Each tent is also equipped with an internal telephone to reception and other tents, an electronic in-room safe and is equipped with a 24 hour electricity supply for your comfort and safety.

The Suite

The Suite has all the amenities of our standard tents above, with the addition of a private plunge pool, outside bathroom with bath tub, large deck area for private dining and your own personal guide for private game viewing excursions.

Lodge Facilities

* The lodge has a 'Naturally Wild' gym and spa facility. Guests can enjoy indulgent massages and body wraps in the facility or in the privacy of their own tent. There is also an extensive under-cover dining and lounge area with views over the surrounding floodplains* Open Fireplace * A hide for game viewing and private dining * Private library with internet access and satellite TV * Fully stocked bar *

* Large heated swimming pool * 'Boma' off site dinner venue

Meals and Refreshments included in your stay

Early morning tea/coffee delivered to rooms at wake up, a light breakfast prior to the morning game drive/safari walk, and during the morning game drive, tea, coffee and biscuits. On returning to the camp a full buffet brunch is offered followed by time to rest and relax. A light tea will precede the afternoon game drive during which wine, beer, soft drinks & snacks will be served at sundown. The table d'hote dinner is served in the main dining area with a wine presentation.

Access to Khwai River Lodge

By scheduled air from Johannesburg via Maun or Livingstone, Zambia where you will continue via scheduled shared charter aircraft. Note: all shared charter flights to the camps are via single engine Cessna aircraft. Twin-engine and private charter aircraft are available on request.

Luggage Restrictions

Unless travelling by road or by special prior arrangement, luggage is restricted to 20kg or 44 pounds (soft bags). Extra luggage may also be stored free of charge at our offices in Maun, Cape Town or Johannesburg by prior arrangement. Alternatively excess luggage can also be flown to a camp or other by prior arrangement

Is fully inclusive of all scheduled game activities, a daily laundry service, all meals, all house wines & spirits, soft drinks, beers and bottled water (but excluding champagne and cigars), national park fees, emergency evacuation insurance and Botswana VAT.
