For dance lovers a Gala is nowadays a precious event: to please that exhibitionist and slightly thrilling love for the virtuosity, that is intrinsic to the art of the ballet, and to satisfy the adoration that the stars can arouse. For the neophytes of the dance it is the chance to easily approach in just one night the universe of the ballet, finding gathered the most beautiful and famous pieces of the nineteenth- and twentieth-century repertoire, together with the best ballet dancer of the moment. When a Gala of stars is gathered around Roberto Bolle, the trepidation and the fanaticism grow even more. His lightening career started after the diploma in the Scuola di Ballo del Teatro alla Scala and his entry in the Scala company, with the invitations in the most important theatres of the world welcome as guest star, the courting by magazine and televisions, the presence as a protagonist and a testimonial to the great international events: an unique case of ballet dancer that succeeds in bringing to the ballet great enthusiastic crowds. Roberto Bolle chooses ballet dancer of international fame for his show, coming from the best companies of ballet of the world, in a program that is differently conceived for each theatre and representation, and that hosts on the stage, at a cracking pace, a parade of couples and solos, taken from the repertoire of the most beloved classical of the nineteenth century and from the most famous titles of the twentieth century.

Paco de Lucía, born **Francisco Sánchez Gómez** is a Spanish composer and guitarist. Recognized as a virtuoso flamenco guitarist all over the world, he is a leading proponent of the Modern Flamenco style, and is one of the very few flamenco guitarists who has also successfully crossed over into other genres of music. He enjoys, and has been a successful musician in, many styles such as classical, jazz and world music. He is the winner of the 2004 Prince of Asturias Awards in Arts and 2010 was awarded an honorary doctorate by Berklee College of Music in Boston.

Paolo Fresu (born February 10, 1961) is a trumpet and flugelhorn jazz player, as well as an arranger of music, and music composer. Fresu was born in Berchidda, Sardinia. He picked up the trumpet at the age of 11, and played in the band Bernardo de Muro in his home town Berchidda. Fresu graduated from the Conservatory of Cagliari in 1984, in trumpet studies under Enzo Morandini, and attended the University of Musical and performing arts in Bologna. Fresu currently teaches at the Siena Jazz National Seminars, as well as jazz university courses in Terni, and is the director of Nuoro Jazz Seminars in Nuoro, Italy. Fresu composes music for theatre, poem, dance, radio, TV, and film.

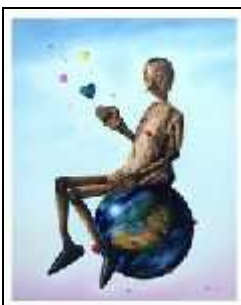

His artistic path spans over 40 years of work focused on subjects such as war, fragments of his travels, mystic experiences and popular religiousness, which are connected by one thread running through them

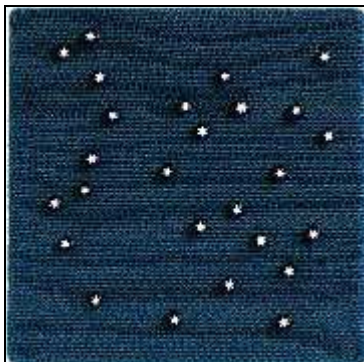
