## *On-Site*

### GOLF

Our 18-hole, Audubon-certified Arnold Palmer Signature Course offers low rounds and a relaxed atmosphere. The course features ancient oaks, grassy wetlands and spectacular mountain views.

**Cost:** Fee per person depends on the season but will range from \$65 for 9 holes to \$165 for 18 holes. Cart, club rental and driving range are additional fees.

### SPA

Pamper yourself with an indulgent massage or signature treatment. Choose from 33 relaxing treatments. Appointments are preferred.

**Cost:** Treatment costs range from \$25-\$300 for combined services.

### WALKING WITH THE HOUNDS

## On-Site

### TENNIS

We boast five tennis courts to challenge your game - three Har-tru and two hard surface. Arrangements for court time can be made through the Keswick Pavilion.

### POOLS

Enjoy a dip in one of our three pools - Pavilion, Club Indoor/Outdoor and Horizon Edge infinity. All offer stunning views, while the Horizon Edge infinity pool is ideal for total relaxation.

### CYCLING

Complimentary bikes are available for a trek around the estate's 600-acres. Trails and points of interest intersect throughout Keswick.

### FITNESS CENTER

Equipped with a wide variety of cardio machines, the Fitness Center provides you with everything you need to stay in shape and on track with your workouts. Exercise classes and one-on-one personal training are also available.

### SNOOKER

Our snooker table offers pool players a different challenge. Similar to classic billiards, the pockets are smaller, so your aim has to be precise.

**Cost:** There is no charge for walking with the hounds. The use of the tennis courts, pools, cycling, fitness center and snooker table are complimentary.



## Off-Site

### HORSEBACK RIDING

Saddle up and venture out into the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Ride along winding trails, across shallow creeks and high along ridgelines.

**Cost:** Guided trail riding is \$40 per person, per hour.

### HOT AIR BALLOONING

A breathtaking way to view Keswick's 600 acres, as well as the Blue Ridge Mountains. Day trips consist of a guided tour and a bag lunch prepared by our Executive Chef. Departure from Keswick Hall can be arranged.

**Cost:** A 1-hour long balloon flight is \$210 per person Complimentary transportation from launch and landing sites.

### ORVIS FLY FISHING

Test your stream prowess with a fly fishing adventure. Fly fishing tutorials are offered to beginners, or just enjoy the company of a professional guide. Half-day excursions available and lunch can be provided.

**Cost:** Half day excursion, including equipment is \$195 for two guests. Full day excursion, including equipment is \$295 for two guests.

What a great way to learn more about American history. Discover Monticello, Ash Lawn, Montpelier, University of Virginia, Civil War Battlegrounds and many other places of interest.

**Cost:** Monticello - \$15 - \$22  
Montpelier - \$16

### VINEYARD TOURS AND WINE TASTINGS

Keswick is surrounded by many award-winning wineries. We can help you arrange tastings at several local wineries.

**Cost:** Customized wine tours with transportation in a limo, town car or van for 5 hours of tasting and travel from \$300 to \$600.

### HIKING/WALKING

The foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains are right outside our doors, and ready to be discovered. The higher you climb, the more impressive the view.

**Cost:** Guided hikes are available for half and full day trips. Contact your Keswick Event Planner for rates.

### CLAY SHOOTING

Take aim at sporting clays - an enjoyable pastime that is designed to simulate bird and rabbit hunting using clay targets. A variety of types are offered, including wobble, 5-stand, a complete sporting clays course and instruction.

**Cost:** Shooting packages start at \$160 and include safety and shooting lesson, gun rental, vest, ear-and-eye protection.

## CHAMPAGNE PUTTING CONTEST
